New Rockford Water Main Replacement Project Receives Funding from Drinking Water State Revolving Fund

Bismarck, N.D. – The Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) Program has awarded a loan to the city of New Rockford for a water main replacement project. This is the second loan awarded from the DWSRF Program administered by the North Dakota Department of Health (NDDoH).

The \$270,000 DWSRF loan will be applied to a \$465,000 project to replace water mains in the city. This project works toward the DWSRF goal to provide safe, clean water supplies for North Dakota residents.

The DWSRF Program is administered by the NDDoH with funding from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. The program offers below-market interest rate loans to political subdivisions for financing projects authorized under the Safe Drinking Water Act. DWSRF programs operate nationwide to provide the funding necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure that protects valuable water resources.
