Air Pollution Control Advisory Council Schedules Meeting

BISMARCK, ND – The North Dakota Air Pollution Control Advisory Council will meet Thursday, Jan. 7, at the North Dakota Department of Health (NDDoH) offices located at 918 East Divide Avenue in Bismarck. The meeting will be held at 10 a.m. in the fourth floor conference room.

The primary topics to be discussed are amendments to the North Dakota Air Pollution Control Rules permitting requirements, prevention of significant deterioration rules, and air toxic rules.

The Air Pollution Control Advisory Council is a nine-member panel that considers and makes recommendations regarding the adoption, amendment, or repeal of rules and standards pertaining to North Dakota air quality.
