Salt Water Spill in Williams County

BISMARCK, N.D. – The North Dakota Department of Health (NDDoH) has been notified of a brine (salt water) spill resulting from a pipeline leak in Williams County. The spill occurred Thursday, Jan. 7 at a site operated by Meadowlark Midstream Company, LLC, located approximately 15 miles north of Williston.

Initial estimates indicate approximately 187 barrels of brine were released. At this time, it appears that no surface water has been impacted. Personnel from the NDDoH are responding to this incident and will continue to monitor the investigation.
