Emulsion Spill in Billings County

BISMARCK, N.D. – The North Dakota Department of Health (NDDoH) has been notified of an emulsion (oil and salt water) spill resulting from a pipeline leak in Billings County at a site operated by White Rock Oil and Gas. The spill occurred on Thursday, Jan. 28, approximately 16 miles northwest of Belfield.

Initial estimates indicate approximately 300 barrels of emulsion were released. Of this, an estimated 50 barrels flowed into Franks Creek. Personnel from the North Dakota Oil and Gas Division and the NDDoH are at the site. NDDoH personnel will continue to monitor the investigation.
