Produced Water Spill Reported in Dunn County

BISMARCK, N.D. – The North Dakota Department of Health (NDDoH) was notified Tuesday, Feb. 23, of a 149 barrel brine spill as a result of a pipeline release. The spill occurred at a well owned by Marathon Oil located in Dunn County, approximately six miles north of Killdeer. There is no evidence of the spill impacting wetlands at this time.

The NDDoH is responding and will work with the company on remediation plans.
