### **Produced Water Spill in Williams County**

BISMARCK, N.D. – The North Dakota Department of Health (NDDoH) has been notified of a produced water spill resulting from a faulty valve in Williams County at a site operated by Zavanna, LLC. The spill occurred on Sunday, March 6, approximately 4 miles northeast of Williston.

Initial estimates indicate approximately 2,733 barrels of produced water was released. Of this, an undetermined amount of produced water flowed into a dry drainage. At this time, no surface water has been impacted. Personnel from the North Dakota Oil and Gas Division and the NDDoH are at the site. NDDoH personnel will continue to monitor the investigation.
