Clean Water State Revolving Fund Awards Loans for Three Projects

In March 2016, three projects have received loans from the Clean Water State Revolving Loan Fund (CWSRF) Program, administered by the North Dakota Department of Health (NDDoH).

The CWSRF awarded loans to the following cities:

- Dwight - \$100,000 towards a \$286,200 project to line manholes, add chimney seals and construct a new sanitary lift station which will reduce the possibility of sewer backups and unregulated wastewater discharges caused by excessive inflow
- Jamestown - \$75,000 increase to a previously approved \$450,000 loan which will finance the development of a sanitary landfill cell which will protect the area's ground water
- Makoti - \$150,373 towards a \$385,000 project to replace a sanitary lift station and force main which will assure the safe conveyance of the city's wastewater

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency provides part of the funding for the CWSRF Program, which offers below-market interest rate loans to political subdivisions for financing projects authorized under the Clean Water Act. CWSRF programs operate nationwide to provide the funding necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure that protects our valuable water resources.
