Condensate Spill in Billings County

BISMARCK, N.D. – The North Dakota Department of Health (NDDoH) has been notified of a condensate spill from the Russian Creek Gathering pipeline operated by Oneok Rockies Midstream in Billings County. The spill occurred Monday, April 25, approximately thirteen miles north and four miles east of Belfield, ND.

Initial estimates indicate approximately one barrel of condensate was released into Spring Creek, a tributary of the Green River. Personnel from the North Dakota Industrial Commission Oil and Gas Division and the NDDoH are at the site and will continue to monitor the cleanup.

Condensate is a liquid hydrocarbon that condenses from natural gas during production and transportation.
