Produced Water Spill in Renville County

BISMARCK, N.D. – The North Dakota Department of Health (NDDoH) has been notified of a produced water spill resulting from a valve/piping connection leak in Renville County approximately seven miles south of Mohall. The spill occurred Tuesday, June 14, at a site operated by Zargon Oil Inc.

Initial estimates indicate 210 barrels of salt water were contained within the tank berm and a man-made pond located south of the well pad. Personnel from the North Dakota Oil and Gas Division and the NDDoH have inspected and will continue to monitor the site.
