Clean Water State Revolving Fund Awards Loans for Three Projects

In June 2016, three projects have received loans from the Clean Water State Revolving Loan Fund (CWSRF) Program, administered by the North Dakota Department of Health (NDDoH).

The CWSRF awarded loans to the following cities:

- Arnegard - \$380,000 towards a \$3,434,077 project to construct a new three cell lagoon system which will provide adequate treatment of the city's wastewater.
- Hebron - \$682,000 towards a \$4,140,000 project which will finance sanitary sewer pipe, nine manholes, PVC pipe, and service to 70 existing connections as well as storm sewer replacement with concrete pipe, eight catch basins, and two manholes which will assure the safe conveyance of the city's wastewater and storm water.
- LaMoure - \$1,425,000 towards a \$5,300,000 project for sanitary sewer pipe replacement, manhole relining or replacement, asphalt and concrete paving, seeding, and site restoration which will assure the safe conveyance of the city's wastewater.

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency provides part of the funding for the CWSRF Program, which offers below-market interest rate loans to political subdivisions for financing projects authorized under the Clean Water Act. CWSRF programs operate nationwide to provide the funding necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure that protects our valuable water resources.
