Produced Water Spill in Dunn County

BISMARCK, N.D. – The North Dakota Department of Health (NDDoH) has been notified of a produced water spill resulting from a truck rollover in Dunn County. The spill occurred on Saturday, July 30, approximately seven miles north of Halliday. The truck is owned by High Ball Transport.

Initial estimates indicate approximately 120 barrels of produced water were released and 30 barrels were recovered. Of this, an undetermined amount of produced water flowed through a culvert and into a stock pond. Personnel from the NDDoH have been onsite and will continue to monitor the investigation.
