Oil Spill in Billings County

BISMARCK, N.D. – The North Dakota Department of Health (NDDoH) has been notified of an oil spill resulting from a pipeline leak in Billings County. The 6-inch in diameter pipeline is operated by Belle Fourche Pipeline. The spill was discovered Monday, Dec. 5, approximately 16 miles northwest of Belfield.

An unknown volume of oil has leaked from the pipeline into Ash Coulee Creek. Personnel from the NDDoH are at the site. NDDoH personnel will continue to monitor the investigation.
