Contained Oil Spill in McKenzie County

BISMARCK, N.D. – The North Dakota Department of Health (NDDoH) was notified of an oil spill resulting from a tank leak at a transmission pipeline distribution point operated by Crestwood Midstream in McKenzie County, approximately 11 miles southeast of Keene. The spill was discovered Friday, April 28, and was reported to the National Response Center and the North Dakota Industrial Commission.

An estimated 610 barrels of crude oil were released from the primary tank and contained within the secondary containment. NDDoH personnel will continue to monitor the cleanup.
