Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Awards Two Project Loans

Bismarck, N.D. – The Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) Program awarded loans to two North Dakota cities in May and June 2017.

- Ross - \$785,000 to finance an improvement project for rehabilitating water mains to provide a dependable supply of safe drinking water.
- Wahpeton - \$452,000 to finance the replacement of aged water mains to increase the reliability of the water distribution system to deliver safe drinking water.

The DWSRF Program is administered by the North Dakota Department of Health with funding from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. The program offers below-market interest rate loans to political subdivisions for financing projects authorized under the Safe Drinking Water Act. DWSRF programs operate nationwide to provide the funding necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure that protects and supplies valuable water resources.
