Department of Health to Hold Meeting on Proposed Swine Operation in Ramsey County

BISMARCK, N.D. – The North Dakota Department of Health (NDDoH) has received an application for a 2,674-animal swine operation from Grand Prairie Agriculture, LLP. The proposed location is in Ramsey County approximately 10 miles west of the City of Devils Lake.

The NDDoH is holding a public meeting to provide information about the environmental permitting process for the facility and to answer questions. The meeting is scheduled for August 23, 2017, at 3:00 pm at the following location:

The NDDoH has not yet completed its review of the permit, but if a draft permit is issued, a public comment period and hearing will be held due to the significant public interest in this facility.
